We kindly invite you to read these instructions **VERY CAREFULLY** for attending the Counseling and Seat Allotment for Post-graduate Diploma courses in 9 Biotech Domains offered by select 18 Host Institutions located in the State of Karnataka under Biotechnology Skill Enhancement Programme (BiSEP) - Batch II. ### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. The Provisional Results of online **Karnataka Biotechnology Aptitude Test - 2018 (Batch II)** conducted on 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of August 2018 are announced in ascending order of KBAT Registration Number at URL: [www.bisep.karnataka.gov.in](http://www.bisep.karnataka.gov.in) URL: <http://bisep.karnataka.gov.in:8080/kbat/>  
**The result is Provisional and is subject to change based on Verification and Accuracy of all the documents to be submitted by the Candidates at the time of Counselling.**
2. The candidates belonging to **OBC and General category** securing **minimum 50 percentage aggregate marks** and candidates belonging to **SC/ST category** securing **minimum 40 percentage aggregate marks** in the online KBAT 2018 (Batch II) Examination conducted on 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of August 2018 are eligible to attend the Counseling session and to select their choice of domain and Institute based on the availability of Domain and Institute following **Merit-cum-Reservation System.**
3. The Counselling Session will be conducted on **6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> September 2018** **at Bengaluru** for the candidates to select their choice of domain and

Institute based on the Provisional Results announced and following following **Merit-cum-Reservation System.**

4. **Venue for Counselling:** Seminar Hall, Jnana Jyothi Auditorium, Central College Campus, Palace Road, Ambedkar Veedhi, Gandhi Nagar, Bengaluru - 560009, Karnataka.

5. The sessions for counselling are mentioned below:

**DATE: 6<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2018**

- a) **Session 1: 10.00 AM to 1.30 PM on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2018**  
Resident Students of Karnataka (All Categories) should attend counselling.

**REPORTING TIME: 9:00 AM**

- b) **Session 2: 3.30 PM to 5.30 PM on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2018**  
Casual round of counselling for leftover / un-filled seats under Resident Students of Karnataka Quota.

**REPORTING TIME: 3:00 PM**

**DATE: 7<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2018**

- a) **Session 1: 10.00 AM to 1.30 PM on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2018**  
All-India Candidates (All categories) should attend for the counselling.

Resident Students of Karnataka are also eligible to participate in this session. But, tuition fees subvention support provided by Government of Karnataka does not apply and such candidates need to pay full course fee of Rs.50,000/-.

**REPORTING TIME: 9:00 AM**

- b) **Session 2: 3:30 PM to 5.30 PM on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2018**  
Casual round of counselling for leftover / unfilled seats under Other States Quota (If required only).

**REPORTING TIME: 3:00 PM**

**Kindly note there is every possibility of the Counseling Session timings getting extended beyond the time schedule mentioned above. Candidates and their Parents/Guardians are requested to kindly be prepared for the extended stay at the Venue. Outstation Candidates are specially requested to have their travel bookings planned appropriately taking the same into consideration.**

- 6. No TA or DA will be provided for students attending counseling.**
7. Students of each session must report on time. Students reporting/arriving late to the counselling venue will have to give a declaration form for attending counselling at another time. Please note no reservations whatsoever will be made. The declaration forms would be provided in the counselling counter at the registration venue at the time of registration.
- 8. The candidates should present themselves along with the original marks cards, caste certificate and other relevant documents as noted below along with the prescribed Initial Tuition Fee amount.**
  - 10<sup>th</sup> / SSC marks card
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> PUC/12<sup>th</sup>/Intermediate marks cards
  - Graduation and Post-graduation degree marks cards
  - SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if belonging to SC/ST/OBC category  
(Note: Candidates from other States should produce such Certificate in English language only to avail the benefit).
  - Hyderabad - Karnataka Regional Certificate, if belonging to Hyderabad – Karnataka region.
  - One set of self-attested copies of all the above.
  - Photocopy of Identity and Address Proof documents.
  - Two recent passport-sized photographs
9. The candidate's original documents will be verified against details/documents submitted during online Registration for KBAT 2018 (Batch II) for its validity/eligibility before he/she allowed to continue to select their choice of domain and Institute based on the availability of Domain and Institute following **Merit-cum-Reservation System.**

10. At the time of counseling candidate shall pay the Initial Tuition Fee of Rs.5,000/- (Five Thousand Only) in form of Demand Draft or Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of "MD KBITS" payable at Bengaluru to confirm his/her choice of seat selection.

**CASH PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR REASONS WHATSOEVER**

11. The initial tuition fee amount once paid to confirm his/her choice of seat selection is **NON-REFUNDABLE** under any circumstances or for reasons whatsoever.
12. In the absence of any of the original Certificates/Documents and Demand Draft or Banker's Cheque, candidates shall not be allowed for counselling/seat allotment/admission under any circumstances and for reasons whatsoever. No reservations whatsoever will be made.
13. If any candidate is unable to be present at the time of counselling/admission, he/she can be represented by a duly authorized person provided all the requisite original certificates are produced and initial fees are paid by his/her representative.
14. Admission to various courses is based on **Merit-cum-Reservation System** as per the relevant Government of Karnataka Orders and the guidelines issued by the duly constituted BiSEP Advisory Committee and BiSEP Monitoring-cum-Steering Committee from time to time.
15. The seat matrix mentioned below is for each of the 18 Host Institutions.

Note: KBITS at its discretion can update the seat matrix from time to time on valid grounds.

16. If any seat falls vacant due to non-availability of candidates, lack of any other eligible candidates in different categories such as SC, ST, OBCs (CAT-I,

IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB), shall be filled up by taking the candidates from the next category in the sequential order of SC, ST, OBCs (CAT-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB) and General Merit.

17. Students who have recently completed the degree can produce your final semester/ year marks cards or a computer print out of your online declared results or a provisional degree certificate duly attested by the Principal of your respective institution at the time of counselling. Your final semester marks card must be submitted before the actual course commencement failing which neither your admission will be confirmed nor fees will be refunded.
18. **All allotments made are provisional. The Host Institutes or its affiliating University reserve the rights to approve or cancel the admission.**
19. We **WILL NOT ENTERTAIN** any requests for change of domain and or Host Institution at any stage, once the candidate has confirmed his/her seat at the Counseling time during the seat selection. Mutual change of seats among candidates is also **NOT PERMITTED**.
20. The balance tuition fee amount of Rs.20,000/- in case of Resident Students of Karnataka and Rs.45,000/- in case of students from other States need to be paid to the respective Host Institutions directly on or before **10<sup>th</sup> October 2018**. **Tuition fees once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.**
21. After the last date and time fixed for payment of balance tuition fees to respective host institutions to complete the admission to the various courses, the admission shall be closed and under no circumstances admission shall be done by the Host Institutes after the last date.
